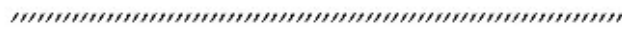

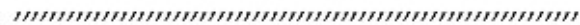

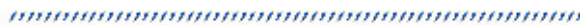

The Erie Kennel Club, Inc. was one of the first All Breed Kennel Clubs in the country to organize for the "Advancement of Pure Bred Dogs". Today, the Erie Kennel Club is the third oldest all breed kennel club affiliated with the American Kennel Club.

Having been organized in 1906 by many prominent Erieites the club began a long history of All Breed Dog Shows.

In the early years the Club had well attended two day shows that drew large numbers of exhibitors and spectators. In recent years the show was a well received one day summer event.

Former locations include the National Guard Armory at 6th and Parade Streets, the Erie Veterans Memorial Stadium, Fairview Elementary and High School Grounds, Edinboro University Fields and Albion Boro Park.
