DIRECTIONS

The picnic will be at Waterworks Shelter #2 which is located 2.4 miles from the gate at the entrance to the park. You will pass the Administration Building, on the right at about two miles, then the Niagara boat ramp, also on the right. Look for the signs "shelters 1,2,3". There is a left turn lane just past the Niagara boat ramp. You will make a u-turn, then the first right, just follow the signs. The shelters have signs on them with the shelter number. You cannot park at the shelter, but must park in the parking lot. It is only a hundred feet from the lot to the shelter. You can pull in to unload if you need to then return to the parking lot.

Dogs are welcome at Presque Isle. PLEASE remember that the Lime disease tick is everywhere. We advise NOT to bring your dogs.
