January All Breed Dog Show and Obedience Trials

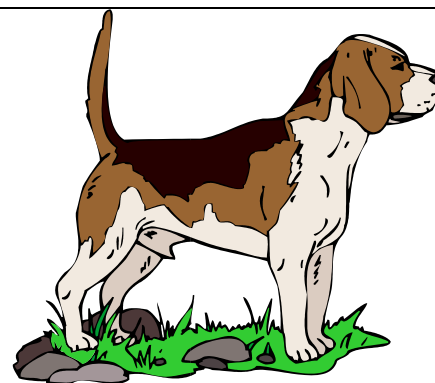
EKC has an advance flyer for competitors that will be available at area events. The flyer is attached to this newsletter and can be reproduced and given to anyone interested.

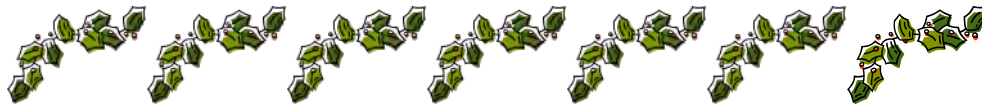
